

LIRR Delay Feeds Acceptable Use Policy

The following LIRR delay feeds serve as filtered down versions of the LIRR’s primary delay alert feed, with only alerts for trains that operate on that branch being shown. In addition, systemwide announcements that may impact all LIRR passengers are shown across all feeds.

The individual delay feed accounts, and which trains they broadcast alerts for, are as follows:

All accounts take the LIRR’s delay feed, [available in full here](#), and only displays the alerts that pertain to trains that operate on that respective branch. Other alerts are not displayed.

The delay feeds are organized by train number. To find which delay feed alerts for your train will show in, find your train number using the [branch timetables](#) and match that number to the series listed above.

The feeds do contain the official alerts issued by the LIRR for trains, though the feeds are not affiliated with the LIRR.

There are minor processing delays encountered with the delay feeds republishing alerts, and some alerts fall through the cracks. All users use the information conveyed in the delay feeds at their own risk.

Tweets that are shown in **[brackets]** are supplemental alerts not issued by the LIRR and are unofficial and unaudited for accuracy.
